

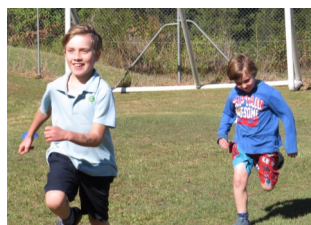

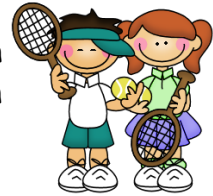

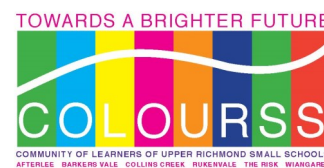
## P&C News

**Where:** Kyogle High School Oval—behind the railway lines.

**Transport:** **Private Car** - nil buses will be running to Kyogle.

(Unfortunately, we are unable to hire a bus that can get to Kyogle in time.)

**Start time:** 9:00am. Juvenile distance run will be marshalled at 9.05am.

**Shoes:** These are compulsory in all events.

**Canteen:** A canteen will be operating on the day. Pre-orders for lunch will NOT be taken. There will be some hot food available as well as drinks, cakes etc.

**Entries:** The list of children & their events is based on our carnival (and some good guessing and consultation with children). **However, all children, even if they did not attend the school carnival, can enter their age race, long jump and 800m (Juniors, 11yrs and seniors)**

For field events, children had to reach a set qualifying standard to enter high jump, shot put and discus.



**High School Students** are not encouraged to attend. The high school principal agrees & will endeavour to keep high school students away from the oval.
