School Fees

played at Nimbin.

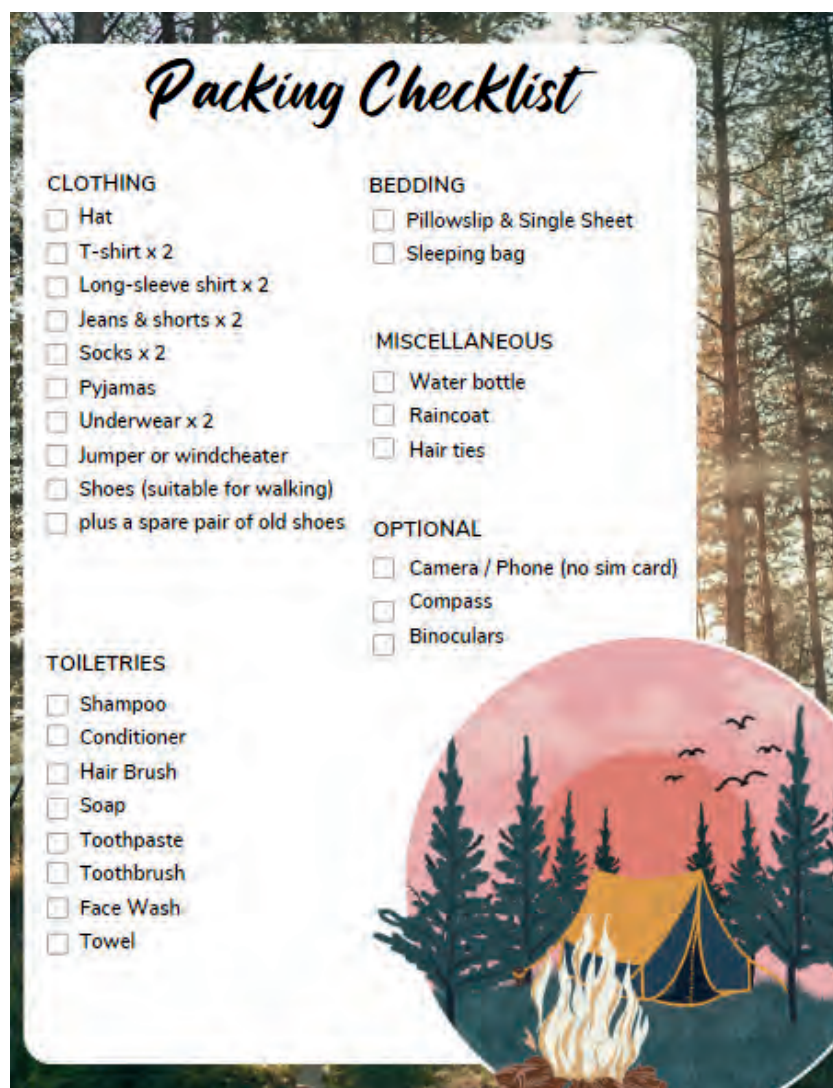
